A. Recommendation to receive and file Actuarial Study of Retiree Health Liabilities prepared by Total Compensation Systems (TCS) to comply with GASB 74/75.

District Manager reports that GASB 74/75 actuarial report prepared by TCS regarding Retiree Health Liabilities provides an update on liabilities associated with the District's current retiree health program as of June 30, 2021 for accounting requirements to round out the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.
